



the little pomegranate

Bunny blanket buddy



You'll need...

- Baby yarn in white (75g) and blue (25g)
- Safety eyes/ black yarn/embroidery floss for eyes
- Fibrefill
- 4.00mm Crochet hook
- Yarn needle

Finished size approx. 10cm for bunny and 30cm for the blanket.
Repeat only what is in the *

Head and body

Using white yarn, working in rounds:

R1: Ch 2, 6 SC in second chain from hook (6sts)

R2: 2 SC in each ST around (12)

R3: *2 SC in one ST, SC in next ST*: repeat 6 times (18)

R4: *2 SC in one ST, SC 2*: repeat 6 times (24)

R5: *2 SC in one ST, SC 3*: repeat 6 times (30)

R6-8: SC30

R9: *Dec 1, SC3*: repeat 6 times (24)

R10: *Dec 1, SC2*: repeat 6 times (18); sew on eyes and nose; stuff firmly.

R11: *Dec 1, SC1*: repeat 6 times (12)

R12: *Dec 1*: repeat 6 times (6)

R13: *2SC in one ST, 2SC in next ST, SC in the third ST *: repeat 2 times (10)

R14: SC2, 2SC in one ST, 2SC in one ST, SC2, 2SC in one ST, 2SC in one ST, SC2 (14)

R15: SC3, 2SC in one ST, 2SC in one ST, SC4, 2SC in one ST, 2SC in one ST, SC3 (18)

R16: SC3, 2SC in one ST, 2SC in one ST, SC7, 2SC in one ST, 2SC in one ST, SC4 (22)

R17: Pinch the two sides together (see photo no.1) and SC10 along, seaming the edges together by picking up loops from both sides (see photo no.2, finish shown in photo 3) Ch6.

For the blanket, crochet through both loops of a stitch

Blanket

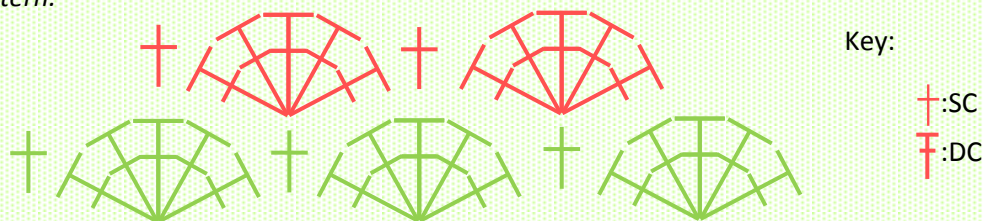
R1: Turn. 4DC into 3rd chain from hook (the chain of 3 counts as a DC), skip 2, 1SC, skip 2, 5DC in one stitch, sk2, SC1, sk2, 5DC in last ST. Turn.

R2: Ch 3. 4DC 3rd chain from hook, 1SC in centre of the scallop, *5DC into the SC from the previous row, SC into the centre of the scallop from the previous row.* Repeat until the last rep and end with 5DC in last ST. Turn.

R3: Ch3. 4DC 3rd chain from hook, *1 SC in centre DC of next scallop, 5 DC in next SC.* Repeat until the last rep and end with 5DC in the last ST. Turn.

R4: Ch3. 2DC 3rd chain from hook, *1 SC in centre DC of next scallop, 5 DC in next SC.* Repeat until the last rep and end with 3DC in the last ST. Turn.

Scallop Pattern:



**5DC into the SC from the previous row, SC into the centre of the scallop from the previous row*. This counts as a 'scallop'.*

In this diagram the previous row is shown in green, and the new row in pink. Two scallops have been made in the new row.

- R5:** Ch1. SC in 1st ST along. Repeat scallop pattern until the last rep and end with 1SC in the last ST. Turn.
R6: Ch3. 4DC 3rd chain from hook. Repeat scallop pattern until the last rep and end with 5DC in the last ST. Turn.
R7: Ch3. 2DC 3rd chain from hook. Repeat scallop pattern until the last rep and end with 3DC in the last ST. Turn.

Repeat R5, R6 and R7 another four times

R20: Ch1. SC in 1st ST along. Repeat scallop pattern until the last rep and end with 1SC in the last ST. Turn. You should have 10 scallops by the end of this row.

R21: Ch1. Sl st 3. *Repeat scallop pattern 9 times* and SC in the last ST. Turn.

R22: Ch1. Sl st 3. *Repeat scallop pattern 8 times* and SC in the last ST, leaving out the slip stitches from the previous row. Turn.

R23: Ch1. Sl st 3. *Repeat scallop pattern 7 times* and SC in the last ST, leaving out the slip stitches from the previous row. Turn.

R24: Ch1. Sl st 3. *Repeat scallop pattern 6 times* and SC in the last ST, leaving out the slip stitches from the previous row. Turn.



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R25: Ch1. Sl st 3. *Repeat scallop pattern 5 times* and SC in the last ST, leaving out the slip stitches from the previous row. Turn.

R26: Ch1. Sl st 3. *Repeat scallop pattern 4 times* and SC in the last ST, leaving out the slip stitches from the previous row. Turn.

R27: Ch1. Sl st 3. *Repeat scallop pattern 3 times* and SC in the last ST, leaving out the slip stitches from the previous row. Turn.

R28: Ch1. Sl st 3. *Repeat scallop pattern 2 times* and SC in the last ST, leaving out the slip stitches from the previous row. Turn.

R29: Ch1. Sl st 3. *Repeat scallop pattern 1 time* and sl st in the last ST, leaving out the slip stitches from the previous row. Fasten off.

Ears

Make 2. Using white yarn, working in rounds:

R1: Ch 2, 6 SC in second chain from hook (6sts)

R2: 2 SC in each ST around (12)

R3-4: SC12

R5: *Dec1, SC4*: repeat 2 times (10)

R6: SC10

R7: *Dec1, SC3*: repeat 2 times (8)

R8: SC8

R9: *Dec1, SC2*: repeat 2 times (6)

R10: SC6

Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Use this to stitch the ear to the head.

Arms

Make 2. Using white yarn, working in rounds:

R1: Ch 2, 5 SC in second chain from hook (10sts)

R2: 2 SC in each ST around (10)

R3-4: SC10

R5: *Dec1, SC3*: repeat 2 times (8)

R6: SC8

R7: *Dec1, SC2*: repeat 2 times (6)

R8: SC6

Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Use this to stitch the arms to the body.

To finish off...

Using blue yarn:

Sl st to the corner of the blanket (between the bunny body and start of the blanket) and SC approx. 130 evenly around the edge.

Ch1. Turn. SC130 and fasten off.

Abbreviations:

Ch: Chain
St: Stitch

Dec: Decrease
Sk: Skip

SC: Single crochet
DC: Double crochet

Sl st: Slip stitch
TC: Triple crochet



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
